



## PREVENT/ANTI-RADICALISATION CHART

St. Michael's CE School is committed to providing a secure environment for pupils, where children feel safe and are kept safe. All adults at St. Michael's CE School recognise that safeguarding is everyone's responsibility irrespective of the role they undertake or whether their role has direct contact or responsibility for children or not.

### PROCEDURES FOR CONCERNS ABOUT PREVENT/EXTREMISM

1. Any prejudice, discrimination or extremist views, including derogatory language, displayed by pupils or staff will always be reported to the Designated Member of Staff. This information is displayed in all rooms in the school.
2. A 'Record of Safeguarding Concerns' sheet will be completed as soon as possible. These are hanging on the Staffroom noticeboard and are also saved in the CO-ORDINATOR DRIVE in the SAFEGUARDING FOLDER.
3. This will be filed in the **PREVENT BOOK**, which is located in the Headteacher's Office.
4. A copy of the above will also be put in the Pupil Record File in the School Office.
5. The Headteacher will decide whether to report the incident/language/event to the PREVENT Team or Social Services. The Headteacher will take advice from the PREVENT Team/Multi-Agency Safeguarding Hub (MASH) about whether to set up a Team Around the Child (TAC) meeting or meet the parents.
6. The Headteacher will report the incident/language/event to the Chair of the Board of Governors as appropriate.
