BEHAVIOUR

REPORT FOR AUTUMN TERM 2019



- For the whole of the Autumn Term 2019 there were **93 behaviour incidents** recorded on CPOMS, our online behaviour monitoring system.
- The chart below shows the number and types of incidents recorded in the Autumn Term 2019.

- The overall number of recorded behaviour incidents has dropped, from 119 in Autumn 2018 to 93 in Autumn 2019.
- The proportion of types of incidents is largely similar, although Non-compliance has increased (from 5 in 2018 to 13 in 2019). The largest difference has been in physical bullying: there were 8 incidents in Autumn 2018 and none recorded in Autumn 2019.
- The number of verbal aggressive incidents has stayed the same, although in 2019 there were 4 incidents against staff (none in 2018).
- There were no racist incidents recorded in Autumn 2019 (1 in 2018) but one homophobic incident (none in 2018).
- There were no exclusions in Autumn 2019.
- Overall, this data shows a positive trend in behaviour at St. Michael's. This is partly due to the ongoing and clear messages we give to pupils about behaviour, additional staff training in September 2019, consistent implementation of our Positive Behaviour Policy and special themed events such as Anti-bullying Week in November 2019.
