



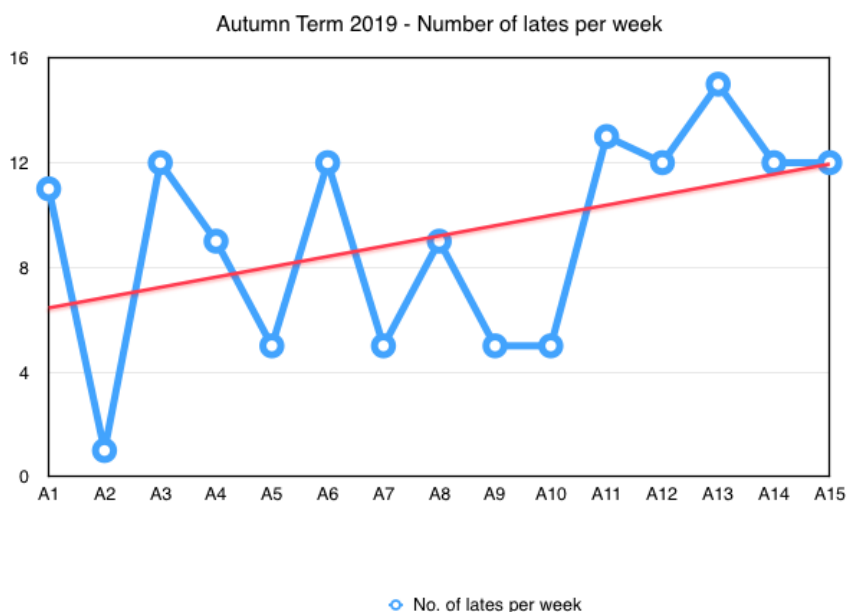

PUNCTUALITY

REPORT FOR AUTUMN TERM 2019



- For the whole of the Autumn Term 2019 there were **137 late arrivals** by 69 children. This compares to 103 late arrivals in Autumn 2018 by 59 children. This is a disappointing increase and one we are working to reverse. This was a longer term than usual (15 weeks) and put in the wider context, the overall trend is downwards (there were 234 lates in Autumn 2017).
- The chart below shows the number of lates per week in the Autumn Term 2019.



- The chart shows that we achieved our target of less than 10 lates per week on 7 weeks of the Autumn Term. In the second week, only one late was recorded, our lowest figure for some time.
- The trend over the term shows an increase in lates during late November and December. This might be partly the result of poor weather and darker mornings.
- The highest number of lates by a single child in the Autumn Term 2019 was 9 and a letter has been written to the parents. Two other sets of parents of children with ongoing punctuality issues have been invited to a SLAP (School Late Attendance Panel) meeting in January 2020.
