ATTENDANCE

MONTHLY REPORT FOR MARCH 2020



- The overall attendance for the **whole school** in March 2020 was **97.2%**. This was 0.4% lower than February's figure of 97.6%.
- The figures for March were affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, which forced the school to be closed since 20 March. Before this, in order to follow government guidelines, a large number of pupils were required to self-isolate because they (or a family member) were showing flu-like symptoms. Attendance since the school closure has been assessed as 100%, with all pupils working on their online assignments at home.
- The number of sessions lost to illness was much higher than February (272 half-day sessions compared to 194). This was again largely influenced by the COVID-19 pandemic: pupils showing even mild symptoms were required to remain at home.
- Our cumulative attendance total for the school year since September 2019 is **97.6%**, which is just above our annual target of 97.5% (see table below). The best attendance (over 98%) is in Years 3 and 4.
