



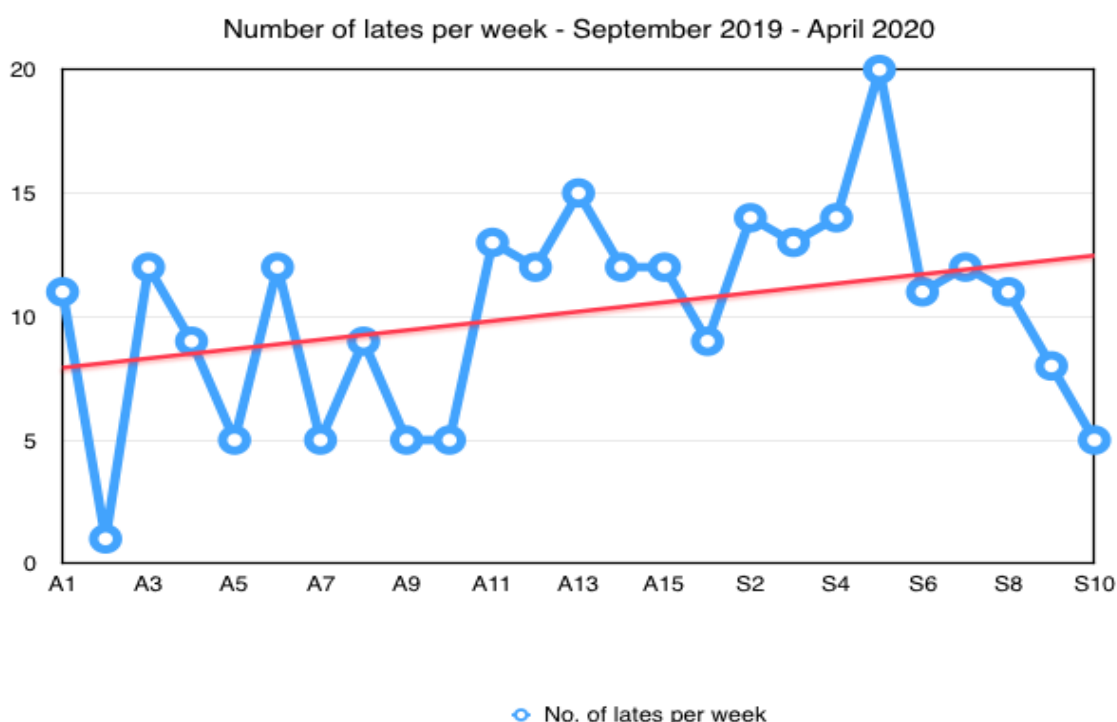

PUNCTUALITY

REPORT FOR SPRING TERM 2020



- For the whole of the Spring Term 2020 there were **118 late arrivals**. This data is based on the shorter term of 10 weeks as a result of the school closure caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Overall, since the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year there have been 249 late arrivals by 106 pupils. The chart below shows the number of lates per week since September 2019.



- The overall week-to-week trend is upwards, with 8 weeks in the Spring Term exceeding our target of less than 10 lates per week. Looking at the termly data, the trend is downwards. There were 137 late arrivals in the Autumn Term 2019 (19 more than in the Spring Term), although this was a longer term of 13 weeks.
- The annual data comparison shows an encouraging **downwards** trend:
 - **Spring Term 2020 – 118 lates**
 - **Spring Term 2019 – 219 lates**
 - **Spring Term 2018 – 272 lates**
- The highest number of lates by a single child in the Spring Term 2020 was 8. This child, who has challenging family circumstances, has been spoken to about punctuality and is being closely monitored. One letter has been written to the parents of another persistently late child – this child has not been late since. There has been one SLAP (School Late Attendance Panel) meeting with parents in the Spring Term, resulting in a positive improvement in punctuality.
